- Uses: Hand apply
- How much of the product/substance used in one working day? 10L
- How long is the worker's exposure? 240 mins to 480 mins
- What is frequency of exposure? Every day
- Where is it used? Inside: well ventilated

First aid



Eyes

If in eyes wash out immediately with water, in all cases of eye contamination it is a sensible precaution to seek medical advice



Skin

If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water, if swelling, redness, blistering or irritation occurs seek medical assistance



Inhalation

Remove victim from exposure - avoid becoming a casualty, remove contaminated clothing and loosen remaining clothing, allow patient to assume most comfortable position and keep warm, keep at rest until fully recovered, seek medical advice if effects persist



Ingestion

Rinse mouth with water, if swallowed, do NOT induce vomiting, give a glass of water to drink, never give anything by the mouth to an unconscious patient, if vomiting occurs give further water, seek medical advice

Handling precautions and PPE



Respiratory

If risk of inhalation of exists, wear organic vapour/particulate respirator meeting requirements



Hand

Wear impervious gloves



Skin

Wear overalls



Eye

Wear safety goggles

- **Maximum/workplace exposure limit:**
 - Long term exposure limit (LTEL 8hr TWA): N/A
 - Short term exposure limit (STEL 15min TWA): N/A
- **Factors which increase risks:** Elevated temperatures, oxidising agents
- **Storage precautions:** Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated place and out of direct sunlight, store away from incompatible materials, keep containers closed when not in use, check regularly for leaks
- **Flashpoint:** N/A
- **Transport precautions:** Not classified as dangerous goods
- **Disposal precautions:**
- **Spill procedures:** Wear protective equipment to prevent skin and eye contamination, wipe up with absorbent (clean rag or paper towels), allow absorbent to dry before disposing with normal household garbage
- **Additional info:** Hygiene measures: Keep away from food, drink and animal feeding stuffs, when using do not eat, drink or smoke, wash hands prior to eating, drinking or smoking, avoid skin and eye contact and inhalation of vapour, mist or aerosols, ensure that eyewash stations and safety showers are close to the workstation location
