Join us for the first annual Elkhart Festival Co-ed Slow Pitch Softball Tournament! Games will be played at the Memorial Park on the south side of town. We will have an 8-team double elimination tournament with the first games beginning on Friday night and finishing up after the parade on Saturday. There will not be a concession stand open, please plan accordingly. ECBC will provide the balls for the games, each team will be responsible for their own equipment.

Tournament Rules

- 14-inch ball
- 7 inning games or 1 hr time limit
- 15 run rule after 3 innings, 10 run rule after 5
- Batters will start with 1-1 count. Foul ball with 2 strikes is an out
- Teams will call their own outs. The catcher will call balls and strikes. A strike is a ball that lands on any part of the plate or mat
- The pitch must have a minimum arc of 6ft and a maximum of 12ft
- Teams will consist of 10 fielders, minimum 4 females on the field
- Teams may have up to 15 players on the roster and everyone can bat as long as there are no more than 2 males in a row
- 3 home run limit per game, any home run after will result in an out and if there any base runners they do not advance
- There will be a line painted in the outfield and all outfielders must remain behind the line until the ball is hit. If a player is in front of the line prior to the ball being hit, the team at bat gets to choose the result of the play or be awarded 1st base and all baserunners will advance to the next base forced to. If the ball is not hit, there will be no penalty
- All plays at home will be a force out situation
- No bunting, leading off, or stealing
- Cash prize for the winning team
