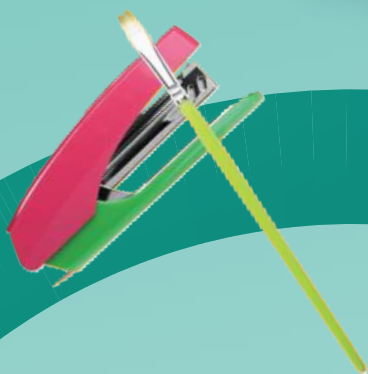

Equipment



A laptop or desktop computer with at least:

- 2.0 + GHZ processor
- 4+ gigs of RAM
- A webcam
- A built-in or external microphone

(Please note that a tablet or cell phone may not have the necessary capabilities to access all the features on our learning platform.)



An Internet connection with a minimum:

- 10 Mbps download speed
- 1 Mbps upload speed
(Schoolwork per learner will require approximately 50 gigs of data per month)
- An Internet browser. Our recommendation is Google Chrome.



Access to a smartphone

With a camera that can be used to download a scanner app to scan paper. Our recommendation is CamScanner.



A printer

- A minimum of an inkjet printer is recommended for printing Cycle Tests, Examinations and other assessment tools and resources.

Please note that Microsoft Office will only be required for learners taking Computer Applications Technology (CAT).
