

The Amended Senior Certificate (ASC) is an opportunity for adult learners who, for whatever reason, did not complete or achieve their Grade 12/matric during their high school years. This programme can also be completed by learners who would like to improve their marks or complete subjects that they did not take in their Grade 12 year. The programme is open to adult learners who are 21 years of age and have completed and, at a minimum, passed a Grade 9 qualification. The ASC makes use of the CAPS curriculum and the final qualification is awarded by Umalusi and the Department of Basic Education.

ELIGIBILITY TO STUDY

The application requirements for UCT Online High School for Adult Matric as follows:

- 1. Adult Matric learners who are 21 years and older when they sit for the Amended Senior Certificate (ASC) Examination.
- 2. Adult Matric learners who have a General Education and Training Certificate (GETC).
- 3. Adult Matric learners must present an identity document or a study permit (foreign nationals).

There is NO formal Admissions Assessment, as the submission of any of the required documents listed above is all that is required.

We will accept foreign nationals provided that they can produce the required documents. The onus is on them to comply with visa requirements from the SA Department of Home Affairs. There are specific criteria for admission to study at UCT Online High School, please refer to our Admissions Policy which outlines all the criteria for admission.

The following subjects are offered for Adult Matric. Please note that it is compulsory to take **six** subjects for the duration of your studies to qualify for an Amended Senior Certificate.

AMENDED SENIOR CERTIFICATE (ASC) EXAMINATIONS

The Amended Senior Certificate (ASC) Examinations are facilitated and marked by the DBE. Registrations for these external examinations must be done by the adult learner in-person or online with the closest Provincial Department of Education. Examinations are written in person at examination venues determined by the DBE in May/June each year.

LEARNER EXPECTATIONS

Adult Matric learners take complete ownership of their academic journey and take responsibility for ensuring that all deadlines and requirements are met.

- We design our ASC Adult Matric course based on learners spending about 3.5 hours per compulsory subject and 3 hours per elective. This works out to approximately 20 hours total study time per week during their studies, but this is for guidance only. The number of hours a learner needs to achieve the qualification may vary according to their previous experience of the subject.
- A high level of self-motivation and good work ethic is required to work through each module, and complete and submit all assessments as and when needed
- A reasonable technical proficiency to be able to work online and master the use of all required tech platforms (G-Suite, Google Workspace, Moodle etc)
- Adult Matric learners will need to be able to upload and submit documents as and when required and/or videos by the required assessment deadlines

ADDITIONAL FEES

We don't like to play hide and seek with our fees.

An application fee of **R50** is payable when you submit your application form. This fee covers our administrative costs and is non-refundable.

In order to accept a conditional offer and conditionally secure your place at our school, we require a once off, non-refundable placement fee of **R400**, which also covers your February 2024 tuition fees, to be paid in advance. Although there is no need to purchase any subject textbooks, learners will need to purchase the required setwork for each of their language subjects. These currently include English, Afrikaans and isiXhosa.

FEE TERMS

- A once-off, non-refundable, placement fee of R400, which also covers your February 2024 tuition fees, is required to conditionally secure your place at UCT Online High School
- Monthly fees are payable every month for the full duration you are enrolled, including holidays, revision, and external examination months.
- Fees are paid in advance, and your first tuition invoice will be billed on 1 March 2024

Please note that all fees are subject to an annual increase.

HOW TO APPLY




Step 1

(available on our website <u>www.uctonlinehighschool.com</u>) This should seriously take you less than 10 minutes. There are no documents to submit yet (we'll get those at a later stage), but keep your latest school report on hand. A **R50** application fee is required to submit your application to cover our administrative costs.



Step 2

Give us some time to process your application. If all goes well, it'll take a few hours before getting an official conditional offer — your golden ticket to a world-class online education.



Step 3

To accept the conditional offer at UCT Online High School, the payment of a non-refundable placement fee of R400 is required to cover costs associated with processing an Adult Matric learner's enrolment as well as your February 2024 tuition fees. As part of the final steps in the applications process, your application is reviewed against regulatory requirements and if these requirements are met, final enrolment may be confirmed.


