JAM Rules & Principles

- During your participation in JAM, there is no dating of fellow teammates, staff members, or people JAM ministers to.
- If you leave the JAM base you are responsible to tell a staff member where you are going and when you'll be back.
- There is no alcohol, drugs or cigarettes allowed on any JAM base.
- All Interns are responsible to carry out JAM Family responsibilities assigned to them. (This includes cooking, cleaning, and other household chores).
- During your participation in JAM you are reflecting the name and integrity of the ministry whether on or off the JAM base, including your time in ministry/outreach and also your personal life. Therefore, your actions should always be reflective of the JAM heart and vision, and primarily – Jesus Christ.

As a JAM Intern, I will respect my teammates by:

- Cleaning up after myself, including my dishes and personal belongings.
- Speaking words that only build others up. (This means speaking kindly, taking others' feelings into consideration, and showing respect for all people and cultures).
- Being on time and fully participating in team meetings, preps, book readings, etc.
- Speaking a language that everyone can understand while in the common meeting areas.
- Submitting to the person leading a group session and honoring them as the leader for that time.
- Not taking anyone's belongings without receiving permission first.
- Being fully willing to reconcile any hurt relationships between myself and another JAM Team member. (This means giving a sincere apology when necessary, giving others a fair chance to speak, minding my own business and not intruding on another person's conversation or disagreement.)
