Exhibits may be left at the Secretary's Office during show week or staged by midday 12pm Friday 22 October. Judging will commence 1:30pm Friday 22.

Entry card to be attached to exhibit by safety pins only – no dress making pins to be used.

Tickets must be produced to claim exhibits and prize money.

Prize money may be collected from show office upon presentation of society's entry card or ticket.

All exhibits to be removed from Tom Pearson Pavilion between 5pm and 5:30pm Saturday 23 October.

No more than two entries per exhibitor per class.

Items may only be entered twice in two consecutive years.

Casting on and off of stitches is to be done evenly in tension, not too tightly.

Joining of yarn, picking up of stitches round neck and arm bands is to be neat.

Evenness of fabric and tension, tension is to be suited to yarn chosen.

Suitability of yarn and colour as regards to pattern chosen.

Any appropriate seaming may be used. Buttons and ribbons must be sewn on in wool.

No shank buttons to be used on baby garments.
