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## Pre-operative Instructions for Turbinate Reduction/Polypectomy

The Turbinate Reduction/Polypectomy is a minimally invasive, very well tolerated procedure that has proven very successful for the alleviation of sinusitis and its associated symptoms. Before your procedure, here are a few simple instructions to help get you ready.

Your procedure is scheduled on \_\_\_\_\_ at \_\_\_\_. Arrive 15 minutes before the scheduled time. You will be in the office for about an hour.

- 1. Three days before your procedure, begin the steroid taper as prescribed by Dr. Morton. If you are diabetic, this may not have been prescribed for you.
- 2. On the day of your procedure, eat a full, healthy breakfast and drink plenty of fluids. If your procedure is in the afternoon, you may eat lunch.
- 3. One hour before <u>and</u> upon arrival at the office, give yourself **3-4 sprays of afrin** in each nostril. **This is very important.**
- 4. Arrive at the office 30 minutes prior to the scheduled time of your procedure to begin administration of local anesthesia in your nose.
