- 10. Describe the basics of healthcare finance and productivity to improve decision making.
- 11. Articulate the importance of healthcare innovation and the impact it has.
- 12. Review types of organizational cultures and determine their organization's culture.
- 13. Recognize the costs and benefits of employee engagement and retention and ways to improve.
- 14. Cite the importance of best practices for clinical and non clinical role recruitment.
