## Misconceptions People Have About Dental Implants

Let's quickly debunk some myths! Here are the top five misconceptions we hear every day from patients about dental implant therapy.

### **MYTH #1: "THEY WON'T WORK FOR ME."**

Some people don't know whether implants would work for them, or perhaps they've endured dentures for so long and haven't gone back to the dentist to see if any other options are available. Dental implants, as you'll see, can work for just about anyone to improve their appearance, their health, and their overall sense of well-being.

There are many options available now to make implants an affordable solution for practically anyone and any budget.

### **MYTH #3: "IT'S TOO SCARY TO EVEN CONSIDER."**

### **MYTH #4: "IT WILL TAKE TOO LONG."**


Many believe that they'll have to go weeks, even months, without a fully-functioning mouth. Nothing of the sort!

### **MYTH #5: "I'M NOT A GOOD CANDIDATE."**

Some people think their age, health, or oral situation prevents them from being dental implant candidates. In reality, just about everyone who could benefit from dental implants, can get dental implants.

# HOW DENTAL IMPLANTS WORK

A dental implant consists of three main parts: the implant screw, the abutment, and the crown.



The **implant screw** made of a bio-compatible titanium alloy that replaces the missing root of your natural tooth.

The **abutment** creates a connection between the implant in your jaw bone to the crown (chewing portion) above the gums.

The **crown** is designed and crafted to match your current teeth to blend in naturally as if you never were missing a tooth to begin with.



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# DENTAL IMPLANTS VS. DENTURES

In years past, the most common treatment for when someone lost a tooth or many teeth was to put in a partial or full denture. Now, even though dentures do provide relief, by no means do they act as a complete or perfect solution.

## Dentures have a number of significant drawbacks:

- Can cause pain while eating, which can lead you to give up eating foods you love like apples, steak, corn on the cob, and many more
- Even the best-fitted dentures can be uncomfortable during use
- Can be inconvenient to use and maintain, requiring additional hassles that make living a fully normal life a challenge
- Long-term denture wearers can actually experience jawbone loss (this is the cause of the collapsed, wrinkled face that afflicts many who wear them)

These drawbacks to dentures, among many other reasons, are why so many patients now consider dental implants as a possible solution. With dental implants, you can toss away dentures and instead have a fully restored smile, with perfectly fitting teeth that look and work like the ones you were born with. They are truly the closest thing to natural healthy teeth you could ever have.

Most dentists who have been trained in dental implants will recommend an implant over a denture or referring you to a specialist because of the benefits they boast in strength and function, health, and appearance.

### Single-Tooth Implants

\$950 – \$1,400 PER TOOTH,  
START TO FINISH  
(Average private fee: \$4,500)



### Implant-Assisted Dentures

\$2,500 – \$3,500 PER ARCH  
(Average private fee: \$12,000+)
