Do you have an AUP?		
• Staff	Yellow	Updated summer 2018. It is signed by staff. Caretaker has not signed an AUP and other council employees.
• Pupil	Green	Differentiated to the learning needs of pupils.
• Others	Green	Parents AUP.
Do you have a BYOD Policy?	Red	The staff AUP Needs to include further statements especially in relation to staff using their own personal device to access school based emails. Statements should include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The device should not be jailbroken. • It must have the latest software installed. • It must be set to factory reset when sold or gifted.
Do pupils have any input into any of the above policies?	Red	Good practice highlights that more inclusive policies are created via pupil input. The SIBD team may want to liaise with the student council.
Does the school have a Facebook/Twitter policy.	Red	It is important that schools have bespoke policies related to the use of Facebook and Twitter.
