2020-2026 Franklin Capital Improvement Plan Description

1. The City of Franklin was awarded \$724,500 through the Cares Act and administered through the Nebraska Department of Economic Development to bring fiber infrastructure to every home and business in Franklin.
2. The City of Franklin Street department will be acquiring a new tractor for removing snow, mowing and other street work. The City has allocated \$58,000 from the street department budget to cover the cost of this new piece of equipment in 2021.
3. Beginning in 2020 with an expected completion date of 2033, the City of Franklin is conducting a large-scale renovation to the baseball field. This renovation will include a red dirt replacement, the installation of a sprinkler system, new fencing, and batting cages.
4. To preserve and improve the sewer infrastructure in Franklin, the City hired Johnson Company to clear the existing sewer pipes, while using a robot to video the newly cleared pipes. This allows the City to check the quality of the pipes and look for areas needing repairs. The robot and video provide an accurate location of where repairs are needed and what needs to be done. Johnson Company will clear and screen approximately 10,000 linear feet each year for five years.
