### Flag State Regulations and Guidance Updates

- USA has released a safety alert entitled 'Saltwater Intrusion Causes Damage to Electric Vehicle Batteries'.
- Liberia has published two new marine advisories entitled:
  - 'Red Rocket Parachute Flare L-35 / L-35A (Pirolec)'
  - 'Implementation of MARPOL Annex VI Regulations in the State of Israel'.
- Panama has released four new or updated documents:



#### **Recent Accident Reports**

Australia – The ATSB has recently published a <u>safety report</u> on a gas control
equipment malfunction which occurred on the liquified hydrogen tanker 'Suiso
Frontier'. This resulted in a gas flame briefly propagating onto the deck, but did not

cause a fire or explosion. It was found that the ship's gas combustion unit's air fan discharge damper actuators were fitted with the wrong type of solenoid valves, which ultimately resulted in one of the valves failing.
