## **HORSE SHOW RULES**

- 1. NO REFUNDS. NO EXCEPTIONS WITHOUT VET RELEASE.
- 2. HELMETS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL RIDERS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 & ALL ENGLISH CLASSES.
- 3. Schooling equipment allowed, but will be counted down in placing over a horse w/o schooling equipment.
- 4. Proper attire optional but encouraged.
- 5. Stallions handled by exhibitors 18 and over.
- 6. No Spectators in warm up arena or arena entrance. Please feel free to take a seat on the benches behind the railing.
- 7. Parental supervision required for all young children.
- 8. Please pick up any garbage/loose hay/and horse manure in the parking lot before leaving.
- 9. Novice classes are for 1st and 2nd year horse or rider only.
- 10. Classes 1-8 must be entered by 8:30 am the morning of the show.

Limited refreshments and food may be available for all persons participating and visiting the show at a very reasonable prices

## <u>Arrival and Show Information – IMPORTANT, PLEASE READ</u>

- Please go down the driveway to the back of the barn entrance to the arena and office check in.
- No stalls are available for show use. No horses in the barn aisles.
   Barns are closed, for boarders only.
- Use your trailer for tacking up and tying horses between classes.
- Restroom is available at the back of the main barn. Port a potty at the back of the arena.
- · Warm up is in the outdoor arena.

Proof of shots and worming from vet or receipts of all recommended vaccinations are <u>REQUIRED</u> for show entry.
