LOCATION

Willows Lodge is located on five beautifully landscaped acres in the heart of Woodinville Wine Country, just 25 minutes East of Seattle. The property is surrounded by more than 130 wineries and tasting rooms, including Washington's largest, Chateau Ste. Michelle. Willows Lodge sits adjacent to the Sammamish River Trail, which provides access to plenty of outdoor activities, including biking, kayaking, SUP, and hiking. It is also within easy access of several area golf courses, Marymoor Park, shopping centers in nearby Redmond and Bellevue, as well as Eastside businesses, such as Microsoft, Nintendo, and Google.

Willows Lodge features the **Barking Frog**, one of the most highly regarded restaurants in the Northwest, as well as world-renowned The Herbfarm, Washington state's only five-star restaurant. Barking Frog has received numerous awards for both its fresh, innovative food and extensive wine list. Executive Chef Bobby Moore and his team excel in sourcing fresh, seasonal, local ingredients and utilizing Pacific Northwest influences to infuse dishes with playful touches. FIRESIDE LOUNGE

The cozy Willows Lodge lobby bar, Fireside Lounge features an extensive list of wines by the glass or bottle, a nice selection of local craft beers, and classic cocktails with a twist. The menu features many shareable plates, as well as sandwiches, entrees, and desserts. During the sunny summer months in the Pacific Northwest, Fireside is transformed into a breezy indoor/outdoor space with a generous patio with firepit and ample outdoor seating. Happier Hour is available daily, and live entertainment fills the space with music several nights a week.

SPA SERVICES

The intimate **Spa at Willows Lodge** features an outdoor hydro-therapy pool, outdoor cedar sauna, relaxation room and six treatment rooms. The Spa offers services such as massage, facials and body treatments.

BARKING FROG CATERING

In early 2013, Willows Lodge launched its food truck, Barking Frog Mobile Kitchen, bringing its gourmet eats to the streets. Affectionately nicknamed the **Road Toad**, the 22-foot BFMK serves primarily as a catering vehicle for special events, including wedding receptions, wine release parties, and corporate functions.
