

### MICHIGAN ALLIED POULTRY INDUSTRIES

#### ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Michigan Allied Poultry Industries (MAPI) Scholarships are authorized by the MAPI Board and Scholarship Committee to encourage post high school education at a college or university with a focus on the poultry industry.

## **Applicant Requirements:**

- 1. Must be a Michigan resident or attending a Michigan university.
- 2. Must be an undergraduate or graduate student that is actively pursuing a career in a poultry-related field or a business with a focus on the poultry industry.
- 3. Must be attending an accredited school.
- 4. Must be enrolled in a minimum of 12 credits each semester during the school year in which the scholarship is awarded.
- 5. Must maintains a grade point average of 3.0 or better.
- 6. Must have work or internship experience leading to a career in poultry. Applicant is encouraged, but not required, to be a part of MAPI internship program.
- 7. Students will be required to submit:
  - a. Application
  - b. Short essay on internship experience (maximum one page, 12 pt. font, single spaced)
  - c. One letter of recommendation
- 8. Students may receive scholarship for a maximum of four (4) years.

## **Scholarship Awarding:**

- 1. Scholarship award = \$1,500 per applicant per year
- 2. Application must be in the offices of MAPI no later than October 20th.
- 3. Scholarship awarding will occur in November, for the current school year
- 4. The scholarship check will be sent to the address provided on the application and payable to the student.
- 5. Recipients must provide a recent headshot photograph.
- 6. Scholarship recipients are requested to attend the annual MAPI Winter Poultry Seminar for recognition.
