

NOTICE OF ROAD CLOSURES

Dear Resident,

We are ReesLeisure the Event Organisers for the Winchester Marafun which will be taking place on **Sunday 25th September 2022**.

This is the sixth year we have hosted the Winchester Marafun, with an estimated 3000 runners taking part on the day. The event will feature a half marathon route and a new 10K route which will take in the spectacular scenery around Winchester and a children's fun run in the city centre.

We have been in extensive talks with the City Council and Hampshire Highways to make sure that the day runs as smoothly as possible and to minimise disruptions, with even further communication having been sent out to improve from the previous years.

The race will involve **road closures and rolling road closures around the city between 8am and 2.00pm on Sunday 25th September**. It is likely that traffic will be heavier around the city centre area so it will be advisable to plan and allow extra time for your journey.

As we are using rolling road closures, the below roads will be closed whilst there are runners on the road and the closures will be lifted as quickly as possible following the last runners. Please allow for potential delays to your journey during the planned road closure times.

Road Closures in your area:

Old Kennels Lane, Oliver's Battery Road South and Ridgeway

This area will be heavily facilitated with runners from 09:30-11:00 approximately. Please note there may be some delays in this area around this time but resident's will be able to exit properties under the guidance of the marshals. Where possible, please plan your journey around the race times to avoid delays.

The runners will use the underpass to cross Badger Farm Road so traffic on this road will be unaffected.

Rooks Down Road, Ashbarn Crescent, Ivy Close

These roads will be heavily facilitated with runners between 09:45 – 11:15pm. Please note there may be some delays in this area around this time but resident's will be able to exit properties under the guidance of the marshals. Where possible, please plan your journey around the race times to avoid delays.

Stanmore Lane

This road will be closed between 08:00-11:00, please where possible plan your journey around the times of this closure.

St Cross Road

This road will be closed **Northbound** between its junction with the A3090 Badger Farm Road and its junction with Lower Stanmore Lane between 09:30 – 13:00 while the runners pass through.
