What can I expect after my root canal?





Avoid chewing until the numbness has completely wears off.

It is normal for some of the temporary filling to wear out.
But if the entire filling or temporary crown comes off, call us so it can be replaced.

Brush and floss normally.

If we placed a temporary filling or crown, avoid chewing on hard or sticky foods. Especially gum.

To control discomfort, take pain medication before the anesthetic has worn off or as directed.

If we prescribed antibiotics, take them as directed even if all pain and symptoms are gone.

When to call us
