HOW IT'S IMPLEMENTED

- + Independence High School uses Wayfinder as part of the advisory curriculum.
- + Each advisory has 5-12 students with an advisor who leads them through the curriculum over the year.
- + They use the Belonging 3 curriculum for 9th grade and Purpose 1 for 10th grade.
- + They are set to expand to a all school model to include 11th and 12th grade.
- + The staff has developed from the curriculum and had a very positive experience with Wayfinder.
- + They used Wayfinder as part of their intentional community building program to help their new online students.
