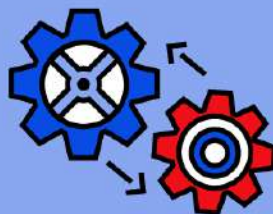

- Our Aftercare Centre currently has approximately 200 learners who are supervised each afternoon and receive assistance with homework;
- Our swimming pool is heated and used by our learners throughout the year.
