Management response	Partially accepted  We agree with the recommendation to focus on making stronger business cases for consultants that offer FBO-capacity building services. Leaving private market, the opportunity to develop commercial services is the most sustainable exit strategy indeed. Unfortunately, we discovered this market is not mature yet in Tanzania. We only partially agree with the suggestion to engage with local government extension workers. We are not sure about the assumption that local governments will be able to pay for these consultancy fees in the place of FBOs. We think more innovative business models need to be found, whereby FBO's investing in their professionalization can link this cost to direct impact activities on their business (more income, better access to finance etc). We also still believe in our strategy to engage with educational institutions that can offer these training services to farmers as part of their curriculum.
