GORSE SCITT is an integral part of The Gorse Academies Trust, a high performing multi academy trust led by Sir John Townsley.

In January 2018, GORSE SCITT was recognised by OFSTED as being Outstanding in all aspects of its work. Over the last five years, GORSE SCITT has successfully trained over a thousand teachers across all subjects in the Primary and Secondary phases. GORSE SCITT also offers specialist training in Post-16 provision and Alternative Provision. The majority of these colleagues are now pursuing careers in our trust or partner schools, furthermore, a number of these colleagues have made rapid progress through their careers and now hold middle and senior leader positions in schools. It should also be noted that anyone who successfully trains with us, as well as receiving Qualified Teacher Status, will be awarded a Post Graduate Certificate of Education and 60 points towards a Masters qualification.
