Travel Information


Public transport is the best way to get to and from the Olympic Park, either by train, underground, or bus. Please see below for maps with directions from nearby stations to the **Copper Box Arena**.

- The nearest overground station is **Hackney Wick** (10 minute walk)
- The nearest underground station is **Stratford** (20 minute walk)
- Stratford International station (14 minute walk) is just seven minutes by train from St Pancras International (& Kings Cross) station.
- The 388 bus runs every 10 minutes from Stratford bus station to Blackfriars station and stops directly outside the Copper Box Arena (stops M & N)


Coach/Minibus parking:

- Spaces are available at Here East Multi-Storey.
- The car park entrance is reached via Eastway, alongside the A12, then it's a 0.5 mile walk past Here East to the Copper Box Arena.
- There are a small number of disabled parking spaces available at the Copper Box Arena

The nearest overground station is Hackney Wick (10 minute walk)



The nearest underground station is Stratford (20 minute walk)



Stratford International station (14 minute walk) is just seven minutes by train from St Pancras International (& Kings Cross) station.
