


The forest. It is in our nature.



Croatia.

Located in Central Europe, Croatia is a country of intact nature with forests covering 44% of its land surface. Croatia can easily provide unique red beech, famous Slavonian oak, fine ash, maple, hornbeam and other national raw materials for production of high quality wood products. Due to favorable climate, the above mentioned types of wood are of a stable and striking structure and quality.

Croatia is also a maritime country connected to the Mediterranean Sea with ports like Rijeka and Raša, which provide express bulk and container delivery for our customers throughout the world.





Oak.

The king of the forest.

A timeless classic, with great strength and hardness, oak wood has a density of about 0.75 g/cm³, and is very resistant to insect and fungal attack because of its high tannin content.

Oak wood was used in Europe for the construction of ships, especially naval men of war, until the 19th century. It is the principal timber used in the construction of timber-framed buildings. Oak wood is commonly used for furniture, flooring and for production of veneer and barrels

Beech.

Strong and attractive, beech is the most common hardwood in the world. European species of beech yields a utility timber that is tough and it weighs about 0.72 g/cm³. It is widely used for furniture framing and carcass construction, flooring and engineering purposes, in plywood and in household items like plates. It is also used as a decorative wood. The timber can be used to build chalets, houses and log cabins.

Ash.

Stylish and tough, ash is great for floors and doors. The wood is white to cream in color.



How does it work?

Production starts in the forest with high quality raw material being controlled and chosen by Exportdrvo's experts. Logs are processed in more than 30 partner sawmills with annual cutting of 250,000 m³ per year. After the cutting, timber can be steamed, edged and cut to elements. Our wood is naturally seasoned letting the nature do its work and making it more stable. After seasoning sawn timber is kiln dried in modern kiln drying chambers with total capacity of more than 5,000 m³. We store our products in covered store yards with capacity 30,000 m³. They are located in major Croatian seaports from where we deliver to our customers all around the world.

Sawn timber.

Edged or unedged, cut to size.

The Exportdrvo portfolio comprises of sawn timber, in fresh, air-dry and kiln-dry condition of all species of Croatian timber, from oak, beech, hornbeam, ash, lime, alder, to many other indigenous species.

All types of hard and soft wood sawn timber are stored in warehouses that meet the highest European standards. Following an additional period of drying, edged and unedged timber is delivered to the market.

Sawn timber is offered in different classes, in different forms, different conditions, unedged or edged, unsteamed or steamed. All different classes are offered (in oak from prime to rustic; in beech from prime, A class, to unsteamed material like pallets).

- / thicknesses vary from 20 mm to even 100 mm, with random widths.
- / widths: possible to produce fixed widths and sorted to size against specific orders.
- / lengths vary from supershorts (from 0.4 m to 0.95 m), shorts (from 1.00 m to 1.70 m), mediums (from 1.80 m to 2.00 m) and long lengths (2.10 m and longer).

Flooring.

From chevron to Versailles.

The Exportdrvo product range is wide and varied, always keeping track of trends in interior design, with the aim of new types of surface processing and adaptation to the demands of the market and end users.

- / mosaic (lamel) parquet in dimensions 120 mm and 160 mm and various patterns (english pattern, squares, parallel pattern, industrial parquet in various dimensions, etc.)
- / lam parquet 10/14 mm in different dimensions
- / classic solid parquet 14/21 mm in different dimensions
- / massive wood floors 14/15 mm and 20/21 mm in different dimensions and various finishing treatments (oiled, painted, lacquered, brushed, etc.)
- / 2-ply parquet of different dimensions and thickness with a wide range of finishing
- / 3-ply parquet with 3 lamellas and 3-ply parquet with 1 lamel of different dimensions and with a wide range of finishing
- / XXL 3-ply flooring in dimensions 2,000-3,000 x 250/300 x 20 mm and 2000/2200/2400 x 252 x 14.5 mm
- / exterior flooring (decking) made from thermotreated ash various dimensions (decking in strips and tiles) and possibilities (flat/antislip/rounded)
- / massive and 2-ply parquets in **chevron**
- / multilayer and massive **Versailles floors** in various designs and finishing touches, all to the wishes of our partners and customers

Edged glued, finger joint...

Edge-glued panels are traditionally produced in oak, lightly steamed beech, unsteamed beech, ash, maple and European steamed cherry. They are most commonly used for making staircases, tables and furniture fronts.

Width of the lamellas is mixed, 50-120 mm.

Standard dimensions:

/ length: from 800 mm to 2,000 mm / width: from 300 mm to 1200 mm / thickness: 19/20/40/42/45/50 mm

Finger-joint panels are traditionally produced in oak, lightly steamed beech, unsteamed beech, ash, maple, European steamed cherry and European darkly steamed walnut. They are most commonly used for making staircases, tables and furniture.

Standard width of the lamella is approx. 40-42 mm depending on the width of the board. Standard dimensions:

/ length: from 800 mm to 6,000 mm / width: from 300 mm to 1,250 mm

/ thickness: 19/20/40/42/45/50/55/60 mm

3-layer panels are produced from oak, steamed beech, ash, european maple, alder tree, european cherry and american walnut.

/ length: from 1,250 mm up to 3,000 mm

/ width: 1,250 mm / thickness: 20/26 mm

3-layer oak tabletop panels is our new product

/ length: 1,800 mm up to 3,000 mm / width: 900/1,000/1,100/1,200 mm

/ thickness: 30/40/50 mm



Veneer.

Sliced veneer or top layers.

Made from only the best quality logs veneer greatly expands the amount of usable wood, adds value to everything it is used upon. An ancient art, dating back to Egyptian civilization. Main features are recyclability and renewability alongside with sustainability and durability.

This pinnacle of wood technology is made from the finest and rarest logs of oak, ash, beech, and cherry.

Sliced and rotary cut dimensions:

- / thickness from 0.6 mm to 2.0 mm
- / lenght up to 4,000 mm
- / width up to 210 mm (up to 500 mm in rotary cut)

Solid wood furniture, doors, chairs...

Chairs, tables, sideboards, upholstered and solid wood furniture surface-finished with ecological oils and wax coats are an adequate product for the global trends, as far as design and surface finishing are concerned. Clogs (wooden soles and insoles) forms a part of our product range as well. The styles are separated, from modern to traditional to rustic, depending on clients' demands.

The selection of finished furniture has been completed with doors, kitchen fronts and a wide range of furniture elements which could (but not necessarily) be surface-finished.
