

Who is Carl Tinnion, Mission Rejuvenator for the Waiapu Diocese?

You have probably seen me floating around the place recently, I am the bald English guy who probably needs a shave. My new job title is 'Mission Rejuvenator' which is focussed on developing new Anglican Church expressions and helping to support the emergence of new ministries across the BOP, and across the Diocese in general. It is probably helpful to point out that this is a pioneering role and not a Parish role, meaning I am here to support and serve Parish churches in expanding, or diversifying what they are already doing, as well as helping to catalyse new vision. It is about creating missional opportunities and helping to build outward facing communities. As Holy Trinity is now my home church it does mean I am able to also start new things within our Parish, which I hope will strengthen the vision of the church while modelling new ways of doing things to other Parishes.

My experience has been bringing leadership to a missionary organisation called YWAM for the last 28 years, working in over 40 countries while being based out of England. I have spent the last 15 or so years working with a number of Anglican churches in the UK, helping to start or support fresh expressions that helped Anglicans reimagine themselves in a post-Christian society.

I am married to Melanie, a Kiwi, and we have 3 kids (all in late teens). I have a Masters Degree in Applied Theology and Reflective Practice through Oxford Brookes. I am also an artist, chef and lecturer and I particularly love the intersection between the arts, theology and community development, especially in finding new ways to communicate faith. You can check out some of my work on Youtube by searching for 'Heavenly Nosh', an experiment in trying to convey theology through food and art!! One initiative I have been asked to get started is to run another BOP **Alpha course**, to be run out of our church!
