

### what do you need to know?

- This year's AGM will be held Tuesday 28 March at 7pm. An AGM is a
  business meeting where we receive reports about the life of the church,
  approve the budget for the current financial year and talk about what is
  happening and where we are going together. It is open to all who attend
  the church but only Electoral Members may vote where the opportunity
  occurs.
- The AGM will include Parish updates and information about the vision, mission and direction of the church.
- Those of you who are ministry leaders need to write a report on the 2022 year and have it to the Administrator, Jackie Kim, by Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> February. Jackie will be in touch or you can contact her for details.
- Nominations for Vestry are open as of this Sunday. Nomination packs, with information about the positions, are available from the office and all nominations must be to the Administrator, Jackie Kim, by Friday 3 March. Nominations must be signed by a mover and seconder, and the person being nominated. We are seeking...
  - A People's Warden
  - Up to eight (8) Vestry Members: all current Vestry Members and the People's Warden need to be re-nominated.
  - If there are more nominations than positions available there will be a vote. If not the nominations will be accepted as approved.
- All parishioners are welcome to attend but, in order to vote on any matters concerning the church, you need to be an electoral member. To be an electoral member you need to have been in the church for four months and have been Baptised. Forms to become an electoral member are available from the Parish Pastor, Donald Carter.

Life Groups, Lenten Studies and Prayer

Holy Trinity has a number of **Small/Life groups** that meet at HTT and around the city where you can both build your relationship with Jesus and with His people. Details of these groups are in the 'Touchpoints' brochure on the Welcome desk.

The weeks leading up to Easter are called **Lent**, and are traditionally a time of prepration for the Easter season. Often we recommend all our small groups use the same Lenten studies material so we are travelling the same path together.

This year we are recommending groups use material from Alpha on **Prayer** to refresh and stimulate our hearts toward making prayer even more of a daily rhythm

- Consider forming a group just for the eight weeks of the study, at a time and place that suits you.
