

Tangipahoa Parish Fair Parade 2022

The Tangipahoa Parish Fair Parade will begin promptly at 10 a.m. on Friday, September 31, 2022. To participate in the parade, please mail your form and entry fee to Tangipahoa Parish Fair, P. O. Box 1293, Amite, LA 70422

DEADLINE TO <u>REGISTER</u> Wednesday, September 28, 2022 EVERY ENTRY MUST REGISTER!!!!!!

The parade will start at the corner of South Duncan Avenue and East Oak Street and proceed west on Oak Street [Hwy 16] downtown Amite, turn right by Walgreens, ending at the Tangipahoa Parish Fairgrounds. Marching Bands, cheer squads and dance teams are asked to enter fairgrounds by Fair Office.

Lineup begins at 9 a.m. at Amite Elementary. ALL PARADE ENTRIES WILL ENTER FROM AMITE HIGH SCHOOL STADIUM on East Magnolia. NO TRAFFIC MAY ENTER S. DUNCAN from Hwy 16, or any side streets. ALL entries MUST enter by the high school stadium. There will be someone there to direct you to your staging area.

Please make all checks payable to Tangipahoa Parish Fair. No checks after September 26, 2022. Fee must be paid when registering.

All motorized vehicles must present proof of insurance when submitting entry. All insurance and driver's licenses will be checked on site as well- so please have them readily available.

*Remember this is a family-oriented event. Only appropriate music, costumes and banners will be allowed. No refunds if you are late or removed from the line. *

HORSES- copy of current Coggins Card must be submitted with application. Any horses not registered before parade will **NOT** be allowed to participate. If you show up without a current Coggins, you will be asked to remove your animal and exit the parade route.

There will be NO stopping and exiting vehicles, visiting, etc along the way. Entries should remain a safe distance from the entry in front of them, but there should NOT be any large gaps. The parade should be continuous. Anyone stopping along the route causing delays in the parade will be pulled from the parade lineup immediately.

*Tangipahoa Parish Fair will NOT be responsible for loss, theft, or injury, before, during or after the parade and I agree to hold the Fair harmless, for any claims and damages, including attorney fees. *

Parade entries should represent this year's fair theme: <u>"From Wagon</u> Wheels to Ferris Wheels"
