**About the Park:** Established in 1970, Tarangire National Park is ranked as the 6th largest National Park in Tanzania most popular for its large elephant herds and mini-wildlife migration that takes place during the dry season which sees about 250,000 animals enter the park.

**What's in Tarangire National Park:** Referred to as the little Serengeti, Tarangire park is a great park to spot some of the most famous wildlife in Tanzania. Known for some of the largest elephant herds on earth, Tarangire is also an excellent location for bird viewing. Located along the Tarangire River you are guaranteed to catch wildlife in this location regardless of the time of year.




**A Day at Tarangire National Park:** After breakfast around 8:30 am we bid farewell to civilization and head to the Maasai steppe with a spectacular view of the unique landscape of Tarangire National Park. It will take about 2.5 hrs. drive to this beautiful park established in 1970 located 120km southwest of Arusha. Exploring an amazingly diverse number of wildlife. Tarangire Park has an abundance of large herds of elephants, magnificent acacias trees all around, massive herds of wildebeests, zebras, buffaloes, and many others. Antelopes can be seen running back and forth to get water from the Tarangire River. Large cat families like lions, cheetahs, and leopards reside in Tarangire Park. Rare wild dogs, Tree climbing python, rarely seen antelopes, fringe-eared Oryx, lesser and greater Kudu, all this will leave you with an unforgettable experience. Your guide will always have a conference every evening with you during dinner or before dinner to discuss your personalized safari plan for the next day.

**TAT Tip:** We advise staying at the Tarangire Safari Lodge, in addition to some of the rooms facing the river with excellent views the lodge is located in the park and very convenient for having a hot midday lunch at the lodge. If you have the time, a night game drive is a great way to see all the nocturnal animals at their most active time.
