

Bulk Waste

Bulk item collection occurs once per month by calling and scheduling a collection with WM. Please call 800-972-4545 to schedule your bulk item pickup.

Bulk items will not be collected without scheduling with WM. You are allowed one scheduled pickup each month of up to three bulk items. Please place scheduled items on the curbside with your regular trash on your scheduled day.

Acceptable items include:

- Small furniture, bedding, mattresses, box-spring, hot water tanks and household appliances.
- Awkwardly sized or shaped household items that do not fit into your trash cart.
- Carpeting, must be rolled into lengths of 4 feet or less, taped securely and do not have a diameter wider than 18 inches.
- Items such as weed trimmer, small lawnmowers or any small equipment requiring oil and/or gas must be drained of all fluids prior to collection.
- Large items must be of size that can easily be handled by two people.
- Mattress & Box-spring sets count as one item.
- Holiday trees are considered a bulk item and can be scheduled for collection.

Bulk items do NOT include:

- additional trash bags
- boxes of trash
- old trash cans filled with trash

Beginning on March 27, and continuing for one week, trash and recycling carts will be delivered to your home. **You are free to use them as you receive them, however, their use with the enclosed guidelines will be mandatory effective April 5th.**

Schedule

Trash will be collected weekly, and recycling collection will occur every other week on the same day as your trash collection. **All materials should be placed at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on your collection day.** Please refer to the calendar on the last page to identify recycling weeks, and WM observed holidays. Please refer to the back panel to identify your service day.

Trash

All regular household refuse should be bagged and placed in your WM issued cart for collections. Cart lids must close securely. Items outside of the cart or protruding from the cart will NOT be collected.

The following items may NOT be placed in you WM issued cart:

- ❑ Recycling -DO NOT place recyclables in trash cart.
- ❑ Yard Waste
- ❑ Dirt, sod, concrete or rock
- ❑ Construction or demolition debris
- ❑ Household hazardous waste
- ❑ Hot ashes or flammable materials such as oil, gas or paint.

Recycling

Recycling not only conserves precious natural resources, it also helps to reduce costs by decreasing the amount of materials that end up in landfills.

- ❑ Place all your recyclable materials inside your recycling cart.
- ❑ Do not bag your recycling. Keep it loose inside of you recycling cart.

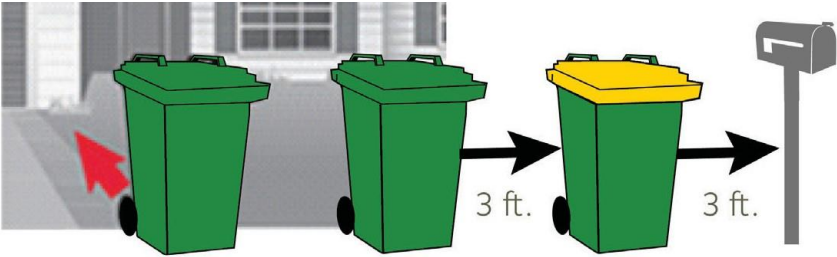
IMPORTANT CART PLACEMENT INFORMATION

The placement of carts at the curb is very important since the truck's lifting arm requires a clearance of 3 feet on either side of the cart and 12 feet overhead.

The carts should be no more than 2 feet away from the road's edge, with the arrow facing the road and the handles facing the house.

Leave 3 feet between your solid waste and recycling carts when placing them curbside to allow the truck to collect both easily.

Carts are the property of the Town and should remain at their designated properties. You are encouraged to mark the inside of your cart with your property address. Should your cart require repair, please call the Town at (716) 652-0589 ext 2.



- Place wheels of cart toward house.
- Keep space between carts and other objects.
- Do not obstruct collection of carts or bulk items by parking vehicles in the vicinity. Keep area clear for easy access by collection truck.

All trash must be bagged and fit inside the cart with the lid firmly closed.

Please have all carts at the curb by 6 a.m. on your collection day
