STEP 2

The Medicaid agency drafts data request package materials and submits to SDRC.

STEP 4

When ready, SDRC shares the data request package to CMS on the Medicaid agency's behalf.

STEP 6

SDRC works with CMS and the appropriate data distributor to ship data to the Medicaid agency.



STEP 1

As a part of the Medicare-Medicaid Data Sharing program*, a Medicaid agency reaches out to SDRC and/or CMS about interest in Medicare data for dually eligible beneficiaries.

STEP 3

SDRC reviews data request package and provides feedback for Medicaid agency to incorporate.

STEP 5

CMS reviews and approves data request package.

STEP 7

The Medicaid agency receives approved Medicare data.

SDRC provides ongoing support for requesting, analyzing, and understanding the data.
