CONTRACT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The COMPANY agrees to pay the total fee for these support opportunities, as indicated by the "Total Fee" on the front page of this agreement.

Following the receipt of this signed agreement, an invoice to the COMPANY will be sent to the attention of the signee. Full payment is due Net-30 Days from receipt date of invoice. For contracts received on or after March 1, 2023, payment is due upon AUA receipt of signed contract. The AUA reserves the right to relinquish booth space for failure to make payment. Remittance information will be included on the invoice.

The COMPANY agrees that the agreement entered into between the AUA and McCormick Place relating to the exposition premises, as reflected in the Prospectus and the Exhibitor Rules and Regulations, shall be fully binding on both parties hereto. The COMPANY has read and understands the AUA Exhibitor Rules and Regulations and Exhibitor Terms and Conditions, available online at AUAnet.org/AnnualMeeting, and agrees to comply with them and with any modifications and amendments hereafter.

Should McCormick Place be destroyed or damaged, or due to other forces beyond the control of the parties the fulfillment of this contract by the AUA becomes impracticable, the COMPANY agrees that AUA shall not in any case be held liable or responsible to the COMPANY for any damage caused thereby. AUA will offer a refund of the sponsorship fee, limited to the amount of the "Total Fee," in such cases.

Skills Enhancement Workshop Activities. The COMPANY agrees to provide to AUA a complete description of the proposed activities to be held in the Skills Enhancement Workshops during the sponsored times, no later than 45 days prior to official start date of the 2023 AUA Annual Meeting. AUA reserves the right to review and approve, and require amendments to proposed activities, should AUA consider that any proposed activity violates any part of the AUA Exhibitor Rules and Regulations, or any existing AUA policy or regulation, or those of any relevant regulatory body. Use of live models is only permitted with special AUA permission and may require special indemnity and insurance provisions. Skills Enhancement Workshop activities should be educational in nature and based upon generally agreed scientific principles. Skills Enhancement Workshop sponsors may not charge admission or any fee to participating attendees.

Licensure of Content. The content of all lectures and presentations in the Skills Enhancement Workshop is regarded as content of the AUA Annual Meeting, and may be recorded, transcribed or disseminated as such, in whole or part, by AUA. License for use and dissemination by the Company may be negotiated by special arrangement with AUA.

FDA Regulations and Restrictions. All medical devices or pharmaceutical products either exhibited or described in Exhibitor literature must satisfy U. S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) requirements—full compliance with applicable FDA approvals as well as with its guidelines regarding display, promotion and marketing of medical products. If an exhibited product remains under clinical investigation or investigational new drug application (INDA) procedures, that fact must be prominently disclosed. Also, if not licensed or approved by the FDA specifically for urological procedures, that fact must be prominently noted. (Information regarding FDA regulations and approvals may be secured from the Agency.) Additional constraints may apply pending further FDA guidelines and AUA-imposed regulations, and the Exhibitor agrees to comply with all then-applicable restrictions. The AUA reserves the right to terminate this Agreement and remove the Exhibitor's property should AUA Management determine, at its sole discretion, that the Exhibitor has violated these restrictions or is otherwise ineligible to participate. The Exhibitor agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and defend the AUA should any of its products or literature violate these rules, or transgress FDA requirements.

Additional information regarding FDA regulations may be obtained directly from the FDA (www.fda.gov). Additional constraints may apply. It is important that exhibitors comply with and remain updated on FDA guidelines for exhibits and promotions to U.S. physicians and health care professionals. The AUA is not responsible for monitoring or approving Exhibitor product displays, advertising or presentations as it relates to FDA compliance.

Warranty and Indemnification. The Company warrants that none of the scientific or other content of its intended presentation is erroneous or libelous, infringes the copyright or other rights of third parties, or violates the rules or standards of the FDA, CMS, ACCME, or other regulatory agency or body. The Company agrees to indemnify AUA for loss or damage occasioned by any negligence, breach of this agreement, or infringement of the rights of third parties.

SKILLS ENHANCEMENT WORKSHOP SPONSORSHIP TERMS OF USE

Each supporting company will own one day increments of programming in an AUA-built 30'x40' workshop; each workshop will be in the AUA show look and will feature highly visible labeling with the therapeutic area title. Included with each workshop is:

- One 30' x 30' workshop space with 10' x 30' storage space to equal a 30' x 40' workshop
- Standard carpet
- 3 6' draped tables for interior; 1 6' draped table for exterior
- 3 5 amp electrical outlets or equivalent
- 25 standard side chairs
- Companies can submit artwork for 1 meter panel sign that will be placed outside the workshop 1 hour prior to exhibit opening for that day; production deadlines apply. If artwork is not provided by deadline, the AUA will use the companies' SEW schedule as sign content.
- One time use of the AUA2023 pre-show attendee list
- All other furniture, AV and electrical charges are the responsibility of the sponsor.

Only the items specified above are included in the Skills Enhancement Workshop fee; any additional items or services can be ordered from AUA recommended or exclusive vendors at the supporter's expense. Skills Enhancement Workshop sponsors are required to comply with the same regulations regarding use of vendors as other AUA exhibitors.
