Thank You Senator Steve Padilla for Allocating \$2 Million to Fight Food Insecurity in Rural San Diego





Senator Steve Padilla (D-San Diego) has successfully secured \$2 million in the 2023/2024 state budget towards combating food insecurity in rural San Diego County in partnership with San Ysidro Health. The funds will be used to establish a much-needed refrigerated food distribution center at Camp Lockett in Campo, a region currently lacking fresh food markets.

Rural communities face significant challenges in getting healthy and nutritious meals. In San Diego alone, nearly 1 in 4 residents are nutrition insecure, and with contributing factors like inflation, programs like ours hope to close the "meal gap" for our rural community. The new facility will serve over 1,100 households in its first year of operations, benefiting communities historically underserved in terms of food access. With the support of Feeding San Diego, San Ysidro Health aims to provide at least 2 million pounds of food annually, alleviating the impact of food insecurity heightened by the pandemic.

Going the Extra Mile: CDBG Team Enrolls 1,000 Individuals in Rural East County





Given the challenges of rural communities, eg. lack of transportation, wifi, and phone signal, the team's goal (to enroll 1,000 unique individuals) seemed daunting; however, our incredible Health Educators and Care Coordinators, led by a fantastic Program Supervisor, worked tirelessly, and recently **met the goal of 1,000 individuals with over 2 months to spare!**

The team has spearheaded efforts to increase visibility, awareness, and recognition of SYHealth in the East region. Over the past year, the CDBG team participated in a total of 53 outreach events in the East region, interacting with an estimated **1,300 community members**, and building trust and familiarization with SYHealth and the services we offer.

SYHealth has exceeded the NIH-established enrollment target for Phase VI of the All of Us Research Program. Enrolling **510 new participants**, surpassing the 491-goal, and maintaining a remarkable **71% retention rate**, **SYHealth leads as the top-performing FQHC in both enrollment and retention rates nationwide**.

All of Us is working to improve health care through research. Unlike research studies that focus on one disease or group of people, All of Us is building a diverse database that can inform thousands of studies on a variety of health conditions, aiming to reflect the diversity of the United States and to include participants from groups that have been underrepresented in health research in the past.

Reach Out and Read is Nurturing Young Minds



Reach Out and Read (ROaR) is a national early-literacy program where medical providers encourage daily reading by providing free book at their well-child visits.. Many of the families that ROaR serves do not have any books at home. At the end of the program, every ROaR child has a home library of books—each given with the advice to families that they are their child's first and most important teacher. As they read and spend time together, families form lasting connections and children learn new skills that serve them well throughout their lives.

SYHealth has participated in ROaR for nearly 10 years and gives nearly 10,000 books out per year. There are currently 16 clinics enrolled in the ROaR program and we provide books in Creole, Arabic, Tagalog, Spanish, and English. Reading with your child for at least 15 minutes per day starting at birth greatly improves language skills and builds a strong social-emotional foundation.
