






Love Your Heart 2023 Annual Report





The 2023 County of San Diego Live Well Love Your Heart Report was just released! Love Your Heart is an annual event where organizations, including SYHealth, provide FREE blood pressure screenings to empower the public to know their blood pressure numbers and take control of their heart health and prevent heart disease and strokes. As of Summer 2023, through the efforts of our dedicated clinic, program, and plant support staff, we distributed over 600 blood pressure monitors and over 200 large cuffs to patients throughout San Diego County – including South Bay, rural East County, North County, and Julian.

We are so proud to be a champion for Love Your Heart and together, we are creating a heart-healthy region so that all can have the opportunity to live their best life for years to come.



Trauma-Informed Care Trainings to Better Serve Our Community



San Ysidro Health continues collaborating with Mental Health of America, San Diego to train and certify employees to improve their trauma-informed approach to adults who are experiencing a mental health crisis. In 2023, over 120 employees completed Mental Health First Aid, an 8-hour curriculum that improves our understanding of mental illness and how to respond during psychiatric emergencies.
