

The following is a listing of all supplies needed. Simply find the grade level for your child and head to the store. Don't forget to ask the retailer if they have a school sponsorship program when checking out. These programs actually give a percentage of purchases back to our school.

Once you have purchased all of your supplies, it is extremely important that you LABEL EVERY ITEM WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME! This helps in the classroom and with items that are lost and found.


