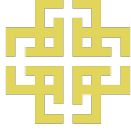
Our Full-Service Package includes matching of a vetted candidate and full-service assistance through the IVF process, pregnancy and postpartum. Our vetting process includes third-party medical records acquisition, psychological evaluation, criminal background check and one insurance review through ArtRisk.

United Surrogacy will assist in guiding parents and gestational carrier through the necessary legal, escrow, insurance, prenatal and hospital assistance. We additionally offer interpersonal assistance if ever needed to ensure all parties are supported through the surrogacy journey.

If a rematch is needed prior to or after an unsuccessful transfer(s) due to medical need as deemed by RE or OB, a rematch will be made up to two times with no additional fees. Once a successful pregnancy occurs, any rematch options will be forfeited. A new agency contract and fee will apply to dual journeys (parents choosing to work with more than one carrier simultaneously) or sibling journeys, at a discounted rate.

Payment Structure

- There are no fees for consultation or to be on our waiting list.
- Agency fee is split equally into three payments and invoiced at the following milestones:
 - 1st payment is due after a successful match occurs and the GC's medical records are accepted by your fertility clinic.
 - 2nd payment is due after the GC successfully completes medical clearance by your clinic.
 - Final payment is due after legal contracts are signed by all and legal clearance is obtained.
- We require the use of a third party independent escrow account for all agency contracts. Once RE accepts the GC records to move forward to medical screening, IP is required to sign our Agency Retainer and fund an escrow account with 15K for travel and other approved expenses. After legal clearance, IP will fully fund escrow account with 150% base compensation. Agency and legal fees can be paid with escrow monies if extra funds are deposited to cover those charges in addition to the 150% base compensation requirement. Escrow will evaluate the account 90 day prior to the estimated due date and require final funds to be deposited if needed. We require a 15k minimum balance of escrow until birth of baby.

After legal contracts are signed, plan for 150% of base compensation to fund escrow.

Fee sheet lists incidental fees that may be required if special circumstances occur. Variables that add costs could include needing more than one transfer to achieve pregnancy, travel or monitoring fees for IVF cycle, embryo splitting/multiples, complications that require bedrest or invasive procedures, etc. Unfortunately, there is no set price to quote, rather information and estimates on fees to consider.

<p>Base compensation: Fee to be divided into eight (8) equal payments beginning at 8 weeks gestation following first heartbeat confirmation. Subsequent payments every 4 weeks thereafter. Compensation will be paid in its entirety if the baby is born after 34 weeks gestation (for a single pregnancy) and 32 weeks' gestation (for a multiple pregnancy).</p>	<p>Average 45k-55k for first time carriers and 60k-70k for experienced carriers</p>
<p>Monthly Allowance In lieu of itemized reimbursements, this fee covers mileage under 75 miles round-trip, local travel expenses for appointments including meals, childcare, fuel, telephone calls, pregnancy test kits, vitamins and/or supplements and other incidentals related to the surrogacy. It begins the first of the month following contract signing and ends the first of the month after birth or at the termination of the surrogacy contract.</p>	<p>\$200/month</p>
<p>Additional Monthly Allowance Starting with the 28th week of pregnancy, gestational carrier will receive additional non-accountable monthly allowance to cover their choice of housekeeping, chiropractic care, massage, and/or additional childcare. Additional allowance may be prorated.</p>	<p>\$200/month</p>
<p>Multiples Fee Amount is for each additional fetus the gestational carrier is carrying. This fee will be added to the base compensation fee starting with the second base compensation disbursement in seven equal installments.</p>	<p>\$5,000/fetus</p>
<p>Medication Start Fee To be paid upon the commencement of estrogen or lupron for each transfer cycle.</p>	<p>\$500</p>
<p>Transfer Fee To be paid at the time of each transfer of an embryo(s) to the gestational carrier.</p>	<p>\$1,000</p>
<p>Dropped Cycle Fee This fee is to be paid if the intended parents cancel the cycle without medical recommendation or the cycle is canceled after the start of progesterone due to no fault of the gestational carrier.</p>	<p>\$500</p>
<p>Mock Cycle Fee If requested by the RE or Intended Parents, this fee will be paid for any mock cycle performed.</p>	<p>\$500</p>
<p>Maternity Clothing Allowance Gestational Carrier will receive an allowance for maternity clothing on the first of the month following the 12th week of pregnancy (by gestation).</p>	<p>\$500/single \$750/multiple</p>
<p>Minimally Invasive Procedure Fee If the gestational carrier undergoes a minimally invasive procedure (Endometrial Receptivity Assay, Cytotec-induced miscarriage or natural miscarriage) she is eligible to receive this fee.</p>	<p>\$750/procedure</p>
<p>Invasive Procedure Fee If the gestational carrier undergoes an invasive procedure (D&C, ectopic pregnancy, selective reduction, cerclage, amniocentesis, any procedure under general anesthesia) this fee will be due. If a minimally invasive fee has been paid out for same situation and escalates to a more invasive procedure, only the difference of fees should be paid.</p>	<p>\$1,500/procedure</p>
