

Gameday and Tailgating Regulations (PBA Reserved rights to change and enforce regulations as defined necessary)

- All Parking locations are sold on a first come, first served basis
- Event rates are per vehicle and vehicles must park within the parking lines or designated spaces
- Trailers are not permitted within garages and vehicles with trailers are subject to RV event parking rates.
- Tailgates (tents, tables, etc.) may be set up in parking spaces at the standard event cost per space used/covered
- Open wood burning or any other fuel sourced (compressed gas, paper, trash, fire logs etc.) fires are not permitted
- Charcoal and Propane tanks or cylinders containing compressed gas (turkey fryers, low country boils, grills, or portable heaters) are not allowed for any purpose. This regulation does not apply to grills using disposable propane canisters of 17 ounces or less.
- No unauthorized use of property resources (power and cable hookups).
- No generators are permitted in any garage facility. Fans parking in lots, who want to watch television or use other entertainment devices that require electricity are allowed to do so as long as they provide their own power.
- Trash receptacles are placed in heavy-traffic areas at each parking location. We ask that you please bag your trash in one of these receptacles or take it with you.
- No golf carts or ATVs are permitted
