The first step on your journey to planet Malt involves a 45-minute conversation with your dedicated Talent Acquisition Specialist. The goal here is to get to know you better and make sure you understand the ins and outs of Malt as well as the expectations of the role you're currently interviewing for.

The second step on your journey to planet Malt involves a one-hour conversation with a Malter from your future team. This could be your soon-to-be manager or another colleague. The goal here is to do a deep dive into the role you're interviewing for to make sure you're a solid fit for the team.

VALUE ASSESSED

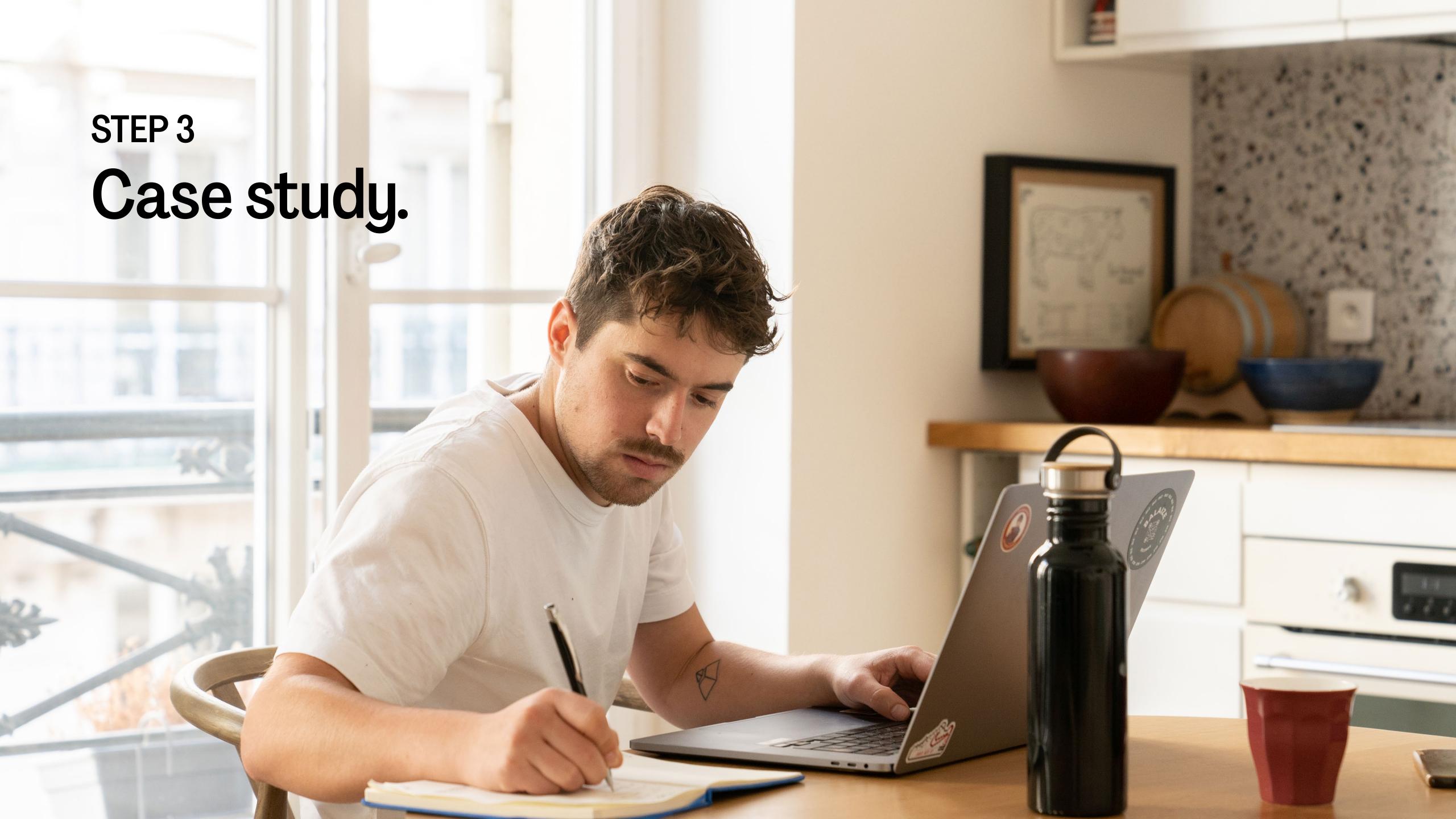
Joy is our secret sauce. We will make sure that you can bring joy to everything you do.

What you will learn

- Gain a deeper understanding of the job you're interviewing for
- Ensure there's a good cultural fit between you and your future manager and/or colleagues
- Understand what day-to-day life on the team looks like, including the types projects you'll be working on

- Learn more about your past work experience
- Understand your career goals for the future
- Confirm your ability to meet the expectations of the role
- Assess your overall sense of enthusiasm and cultural fit with your future team





The third step on your journey to planet Malt involves preparing a presentation that demonstrates both your industry knowledge and your mastery of the skills required for the role you've applied for. The assignments vary from team to team and require about 5-10 hours of prep time. The work completed will be presented to a member of your future team during a one-hour meeting.

What you will learn

- Understand the day-to-day or technical requirements of the role
- Determine whether or not the role matches your expectations

- Assess your technical and problem-solving skills within a "real world" context
- Verify your soft skills, as it relates your cultural fit with the team
- Understand your process for making business critical decisions







The fourth and final step on your journey to planet Malt involves a one-hour conversation with a member from our senior leadership team. This is an opportunity to ask questions about Malt's vision for the future and a great way to learn about how your role will make an impact on achieving that vision.

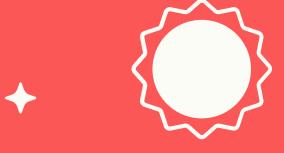
Ambition is the way. We will make sure you have enough personal and professional ambition to join us.
