BETCLIC CO-CREATION PROJECT – APPLICATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Acceptance of the Terms and Conditions of the application

- (ii) the application does not contain any material that is defamatory, discriminatory, obscene or infringes the rights of any third party (including, and without limitation, intellectual property rights, privacy, publicity or other personal or proprietary rights);

- (iv) all information contained in the application is true, accurate and up-to-date.
- 2.3 You are over 18 years of age at the time you submit your application.

- 2.5 You acknowledge and agree that Betclic is under no obligation to treat your application as confidential but will do so in good faith wherever possible.

4. Selection process
