Materials Needed:

- Flat Rocks
- Washable Paint (Any Colors)
- Paint Brush
- Paper
- Pencil
- Black Market (Permanent)

How To Create Thankful Rocks:

- 1. Spend time outside with your little one as they find flat rocks.
- 2. Rinse off the flat rocks with water.
- 3. Wait for the rocks to dry.
- 4. Using paper and pencil, help your little one create a list of the things they are thankful for.
- 5. Let your little one paint the rocks however they would like.
- 6. Wait for the rocks to dry.
- 7. Once the rocks are dry, help your little one write the items from their thankful list onto the rocks with the black marker.

Heads Up: Be sure to help your little one avoid getting the marker on their clothes.

8. Display the thankful rocks around your home or yard for all to see!
