



Fall is in full swing! **PLAY** with your little one as they learn their letters with pumpkin puzzles.

Materials Needed:

- Orange Construction Paper
- Green Construction Paper
- Black Marker, Crayon or Colored Pencil
- Glue
- Scissors

Make Your Pumpkin Puzzle:

- 1. Cut out 26 circular shapes from the orange construction paper to represent pumpkins.
- 2. Cut out 26 triangles or squares to represent pumpkin stems.
- 3. Glue one pumpkin stem to each pumpkin.
- 4. Use a black marker, crayon or colored pencil to write capital letters, A Z, on half of each pumpkin (one letter per pumpkin).
- 5. Depending on your little one's age, they might need help with this step.
- 6. Repeat step 2 on the other side of the pumpkin by writing the corresponding lowercase letter.
- 7. Cut the pumpkins in half to where the capital letters and lowercase letters are split.
- 8. Tip: Cut each pumpkin differently to make the activity more "puzzle" like.
- 9. Match the capital letter to the corresponding lowercase letter to make a full pumpkin puzzle!
