

Make your own SCHOOL B

It's time to hop on the school bus for this fun craft! Through this activity, kids can create their own version of the school bus. This is a great way to PLAY with your little one as they get ready to transition into the school year.

Materials Needed:

- Paper Plate
- Black Construction Paper
- White Crayon, Marker or Colored
- Yellow Paint (Washable)
- Paintbrush
- Child Safe Scissors
- Glue

How to Make Your Own School Bus:

- 1. Cut your paper plate in half.
- 2. Pour out your yellow paint onto the extra half of the paper plate.
- 3. Dip your paintbrush into the yellow paint and both halves of the cut paper plate.
- 4. Help your little one cut out the shapes needed to create a school bus.
 - a. 2 circles
 - b. 2 small squares
 - c. 2 small triangles
 - d.1 rectangle the width of the cut paper plate
- 5. Help your little one write "School Bus" with the white crayon, marker or colored pencil on one side of the rectangle.
- 6. Once the paint is dry, glue the circles to the bottom of the paper plate leaving about half of the circle glued to the plate and half of the circle hanging from the plate.
- 7. Glue the rectangle across the width of the middle of the plate.
- 8. Glue the squares and triangles above the rectangle however your little one would like. This represents the windows on the bus.
- 9. Enjoy your new school bus!
