Subject: STEAM, social sciences, makerspaces

Format: Individual or in groups

Duration: Approx. 1 hour



Introduction and lesson objectives:

This lesson is a great class activity to conduct at the beginning of the school year: a moment when neither students nor the teacher know one another very well.

Creating a virtual seating plan in CoSpaces Edu is much more interesting than in a standard format because it provides an opportunity for students to introduce and represent themselves through animations and dialogues.

It will also give teachers a nice picture of the whole class.

- 1. Change the location of the seats based on the classroom setting. You may need to duplicate and rotate the desks and chairs.
- 2. Change the appearance of the characters to match your own style as a student in this classroom.
- **3.** Double or right-click the characters to add **Speech** bubbles. In each character's text bubble, type the name of the students in this class.
- 4. You can add animations to turn your seating plan to life.
 Double or right-click the characters and select any Animation you like.
- 5. You can also add various items to decorate your virtual classroom. Get creative!
