Overview of our social investment programme

bp has been delivering energy solutions for Indonesia for more than 55 years, and we will continue to deliver long-term value for our customers, communities and all our stakeholders in Indonesia. Our businesses in Indonesia are: Tangguh LNG (gas field and LNG plant), Castrol Indonesia (lubricants), bp-AKR service stations, Air bp-AKR Aviation (aviation fuel), and Jasatama Petroindo (integrated fuel supply and trading).

We have been operating Tangguh LNG in Teluk Bintuni, West Papua, since 2009. Tangguh is Indonesia's largest gas-producing field, accounting for 20% of the country's gas output, and Tangguh LNG has safely delivered more than 1,500 cargoes to date. Our team is 99% Indonesian, with more than 70% being local Papuans.



As part of our AMDAL commitments, and in line with international standards, we have established the Tangguh Sustainable Development Programme (TSDP), which is our social investment programme that aims to deliver quality of life and local economic resilience improvements to indigenous communities surrounding Tangguh and contribute to Tangguh's sustainable operations.

The TSDP runs initiatives in community health, livelihood and Papuan entrepreneurship, governance, Papuan development, and education. It has invested more than USD 35 million to date. Several key achievements of the programme include:

- **Community Health:** Close to 0% annual malaria incidence in Teluk Bintuni, from 87.5% in 2006. The early diagnosis and treatment programme was awarded the UN Public Service Award in 2018 for "reaching the poorest and most vulnerable through inclusive services and partnerships."
- **Education and Papuan development:** More than 100 high school graduates from Teluk Bintuni, Fakfak, Manokwari and Sorong trained to work as technicians at Tangguh LNG with internationally certified qualifications.

- **Local economic development:** More than USD 6.1 million of revenues to community cooperatives, supplying over 3,400 tonnes of agriculture and fishery products to Tangguh LNG catering.
- More than 30 Papuan companies and suppliers involved in Tangguh's supply chain, with cumulative contract value exceeding USD 250 million.
- Support to the establishment of 8 businesses led and operated by Indigenous Papuans, with presence in Teluk Bintuni, Sorong and Manokwari.
