The undeniable presence of a variety of differences among individuals.

EQUITY

The state where all individuals have what they need to thrive, regardless of who they are, where they come from, and what they look like.

INCLUSION

The practice of ensuring that all individuals have a seat at the table, and feel a sense of dignity, respect, and belonging.

COMMITMENTS

UNLEARNING

Unconscious bias training, drawing out and reflecting on our preconceptions and beliefs

LEARNING

Radical listening and reciprocal knowledge exchange with communities who have been made vulnerable

AMPLIFICATION

Creating spaces that center communities who have been made vulnerable, influencing wider change on decoloniality and systemic injustices within the global health field

REFLEXIVITY

Practicing self-reflection and self-examination, continuously reflecting on how we do things & how we can do better, improving accessibility in all we do

ACCOUNTABILITY

Creating and committing to actionable steps, being transparent about our progress, holding annual check-ins

DECARBONIZATION

Fostering planetary health by reducing our carbon footprint and considering all life forms impacted by colonialism and industrial capitalism
