The Windermere Stanwood Camano Island Soap Box Derby Committee is pleased to be able to offer you the opportunity to participate in the Stanwood Camano Island Soap Box Derby. Local businesses and individuals have generously offered the use of their Soap Box Derby cars to qualifying youth. You will be representing the owner of the car and their business at all Soap Box Derby activities that you attend.

As the driver of a sponsored car you agree to the following:

- Demonstrate good sportsmanship at all times.
- Obtain a written copy of the building plans for the car you are driving.

- Rebuild and tune-up the car as required by the Soap Box Derby rules.
- Be knowledgeable about the rules and protocols of the race.
- Do not paint or apply decals to the car without permission from the owner.
- Maintain the car in racing condition and report any damage to the owner.
- Replace any parts damaged during the time you are using the car.
- Return the car and the helmet to the SBD headquarters at the end of the racing season.
- Send a written thank you note to the owner of your car.
- Be available to attend the Soap Box Derby Championship in Akron Ohio.
- Disassemble the car if required.
- Agree to provide 4 hours of volunteer service during the racing season.

Windermere Stanwood Camano Island Soap Box Derby Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

The International Soap Box Derby, Inc. has implemented the following Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct for the important message it holds about the proper role of parents in supporting their child in racing. Parents MUST read, understand and sign this form prior to their children participating in our races.

Any parent guilty of improper conduct at any Soap Box Derby event will be asked to leave the facility and may be suspended from following events. Repeat violations may cause forfeiture of the privilege of attending all events.

I therefore agree:

- 1. I will not force my child to participate in the Soap Box Derby racing.
- 2. I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the activity is for the youth, not adults.
- I will inform the Race Director of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
- 4. I will learn the rules and policies of the organization.
- I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for participants, officials and spectators at every race or any related event.
- I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, racer, or parent such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language and gestures.
- 7. I will not encourage any behaviors or practices that would endanger the health and well being of the participants, officials and spectators.
- 8. I will teach my child to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- 9. I will demand that my child treat other participants, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.

- I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a race or his/her performance.
- 11. I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard, and make my child feel like a winner every time.
- 12. I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a competition.
- 13. I will emphasize skill development and practices and how they benefit my child over winning. I will also de-emphasize races and competition in the lower age groups.
- 14. I will promote the emotional and physical wellbeing of the racers ahead of any personal desire I may have for my child to win.
- 15. I will respect the officials and their authority during races and I will never question, discuss, or confront others at the race track, and will take time to speak with officials at an agreed upon time and place.
- 16. I will demand an environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and I will refrain from theri use at all events.
- 17. I acknowledge and agree that any decisions of the officials of the Soap Box Derby shall be final and binding upon me and my child in all respects and at all times.

Windermere Stanwood Camano Island Soap Box Derby Additional Car Handler/Mentor Responsibilities

18. I will attend build clinics as necessary to help driver disassemble and rebuild the car using the All American Soap Box Derby Plans.
19. I will attend the Driver's Banquet the Thursday before race day with the driver to go over last minute instructions for race day.
20. I am physically able to move cars at build clinics, practice days and race day. Cars can weigh up to 200 lbs. with weights installed. If I am not physically able, I will bring someone who is able.
21. I will stay tuned in on race day to when and where the car and driver are supposed to be at all times. I will make sure when the driver's name is called, they are in the race que with their car.
22. I will make every effort to stay until the end of the race and participate in the awards ceremony with my driver.
