## Lasurdo's Legacy Lives On



What you may not know is Jerry Lasurdo, former resident of Jefferson's Ferry, purchased more than 75% of the plaques on the Celebration of Life Tree in the Bove Health Center. Every time one of his friends or acquaintances passed away, he would purchase a plaque in their memory. One day he came into the Foundation office and asked "who's going to continue this when I'm not here anymore?" Kaylin just looked at him and told him not to worry about that.

Since his passing, only one plaque has been purchased.

Jerry strongly supported Jefferson's Ferry and continues to do so today. We are proud to say that we will continue his legacy of purchasing plaques for those who passed. *As of January 1, 2017*, when a resident passes away, if the family does not come forward and purchase a plaque in his/her memory within six months, one will be provided on the Celebration of Life Tree (one would need to have been a resident of Jefferson's Ferry for a minimum of one year). Jerry's legacy will live on and continue to commemorate friends who have passed for years to come.

# Staff Holiday & Staff Education and Assistance Funds

Residents are always talking about how wonderful the staff is and the great work they do year round. Often times they want to reward the staff for their excellence by tipping, however, tipping is not allowed here at Jefferson's Ferry.

Instead, the Residents Council gets together to collect funds to give staff a holiday bonus check. This year they raised just over \$170,000, which was a record high. Way to go!!

The Foundation also has an ongoing fund to assist employees of Jefferson's Ferry with education costs, textbooks and hardship loans. Last year, 11 employees utilized this support.

**Sterling Donors**: \$25,000 - \$49,999

Benefactors: \$15,000 - \$24,999 Partners: \$10,000 - \$14,999

Patrons: \$5,000- \$9,999 Supporters: \$2,500 - \$4,999

Friends: \$1,000 - \$2,499






