



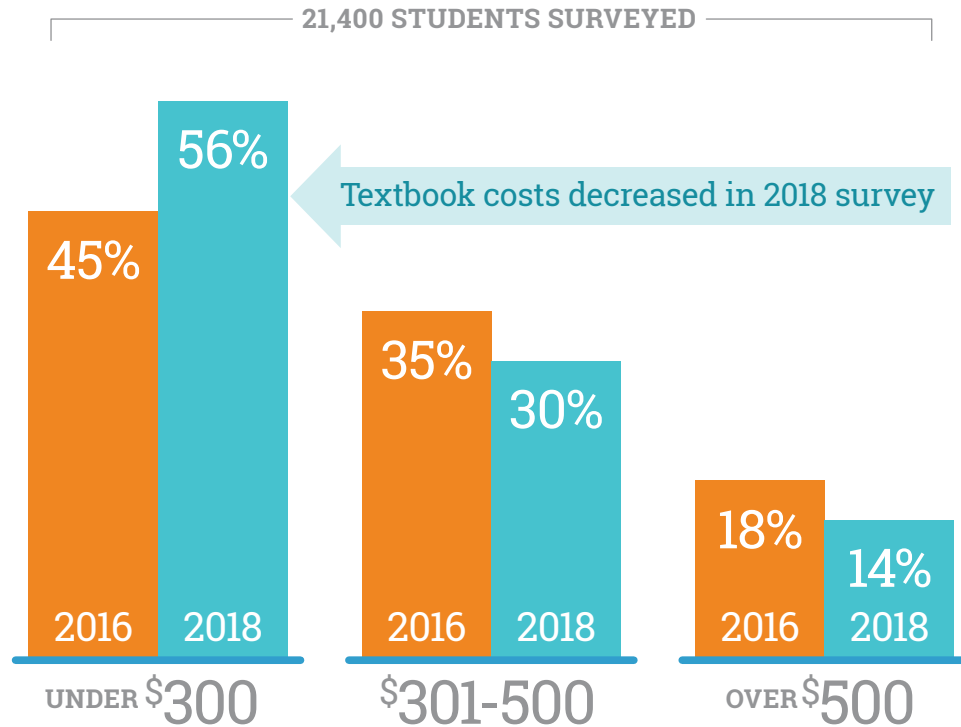

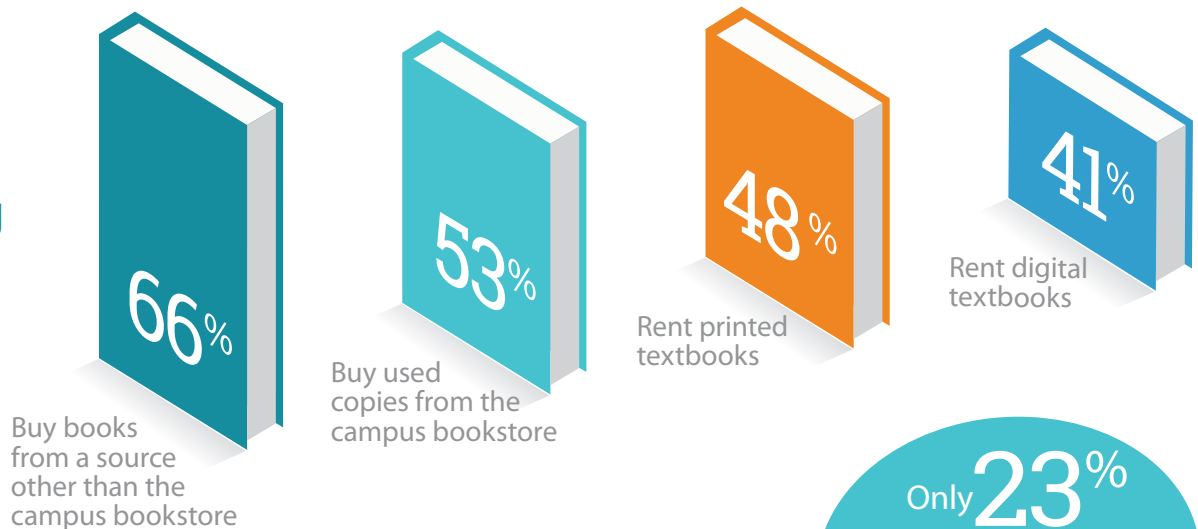

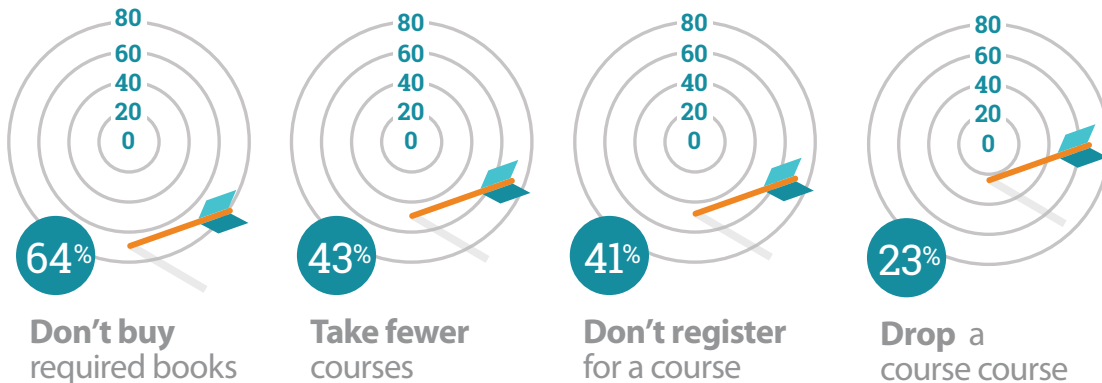
Only **23%**

textbooks.



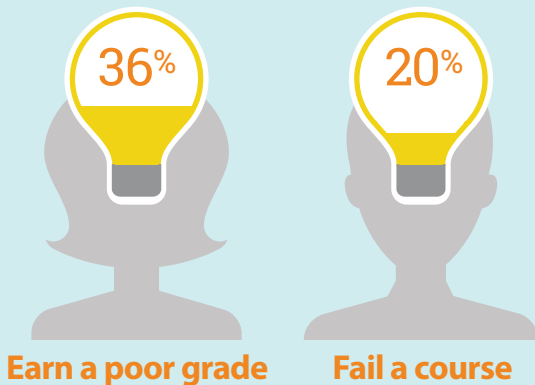
## IMPACT OF TEXTBOOK COSTS ON STUDENT PROGRESS
