Migwetth to all our Tribal Citizens and Tribal Council for their ongoing faith in our plan to build generational wealth for our people.



MNO·BMADSEN Letter From Julio Martinez - CEO


A new beginning is the overriding theme for 2023, with 2022 in the rearview mirror and a post COVID world to deal with. There are certainly challenges and differences in how we do business, but there are also new opportunities that have been uncovered by the changes post-pandemic. Mno-Bmadsen's core investment strategy, and a strategic shift for 2022 allowed us to continue to grow our existing portfolio holdings. We are on track for significant growth both in terms of size and profitability as well as in further diversification of the portfolio in 2023. All these successes allow for us to continue our mandate under our charter to diversify revenue streams for future generations of the Pokagon people.

In 2022 Mno made a shift in its investment strategy away from using acquisitions as the principle growth strategy and directed investment inward towards expanding the scope and breadth of our existing portfolio companies. That is not to say we did not continue to source and evaluate new companies for acquisition. Starting in late 2021 and continuing through most of 2022 sellers were simply asking too much when selling existing businesses. Economic conditions (low interest rates and an abundance of cash) led to this anomaly in the market. These Economics have changed and continue to change. As of the writing of this letter we are finalizing our latest acquisition and expect to provide an announcement to you soon.

- WBK Engineering headquartered in St. Charles, IL expanded into a larger state of the art office in Battle Creek, MI. This expanded presence seeds growth for WBK both in terms of work and staff. The strategy has already proven to be a success. The proximity to several Tribes has led to significant work including a large engagement with Gun Lake Investments.
- Blue Star Integrative Studios headquartered in Tulsa OK, also expanded into new office facilities leading our strategy to further build our Tribal work in that region. We are actively adding professional staff, and expect robust growth as we enter into our third year for Blue Star.
- DA Dodd adapted to the current state of the economy as it pertains to pricing and procurement of equipment by shifting how they do business. Equipment is now bought and stored once a project is awarded to protect against delivery time and price increases. To facilitate this Mno's Redtail Properties acquired a commercial/industrial property in South Bend to store the equipment until job site deployment. The property also has various other tenants.
- Mno-Bmadsen entered into a historic three Tribe partnership with Gun Lake Investment, and Odawa Economic Holdings, forming Aki Construction. This partnership is in its formation, and we expect various co-investments as this partnership matures.

Despite the economic pressures of 2022, Mno-Bmadsen showed strong profitability across our investment sectors. We expect 2023 to be another record year for Mno-Bmadsen.

We begin 2023 continuing to seek strategic acquisitions while continuing the commitment to invest in our current portfolio companies helping speed growth and expansion.

We want to thank the Pokagon Tribal Council for its continued support. I also want to thank the Mno-Bmadsen Board of Directors for the trust and support. Without their dedication to the mission our continued growth would not be as robust. Finally, I want to thank the staff at Mno and at our portfolio companies. We would not be the success we are without them. They are the backbone of Mno, and we are lucky to have them.

What is Mno-Bmadsen and what purpose does it serve?

Mno-Bmadsen is an independently managed instrumentality of the Pokagon Band of Potawatomi and was launched in 2012. Our purpose is to invest a portion of the band's treasury in order to deliver diversified generational wealth for the tribe's estimated 5,900 citizens.

What is Mno-Bmadsen's investment strategy?

In pursuit of our mission we buy, hold and grow investments in the professional services, construction, manufacturing, and commercial real estate sectors.

Is Mno-Bmadsen profitable?

Yes, Mno-Bmadsen is profitable. Mno-Bmadsen became a selfsustained business at the end of 2015. Since then, we have increased our profitability and margins and we project financial performance to continue to grow this year.

<u>Does Mno-Bmadsen have a preference</u> <u>policy for tribal hiring?</u>

Yes. Mno-Bmadsen has developed the Pathways program in collaboration with the tribal government's department of education to recruit, train and place our people in jobs with our Family of Companies, customers and partners.

1. Supportive Housing Complex

Planning and design of a mixed-use, 16-unit apartment complex to provide individuals and their families with safe, affordable housing and assistance while recovering from substance abuse disorders. Development will provide residents with immersive care to fully restore health, purpose, and meaning in the lives of those who inhabit the space in Mt. Pleasant Michigan.

2. New Vertical Milling Machines From Hurco

We added two new Hurco VMX42i machines. The tool spindle moves in a vertical position to the work piece on the table. These machines can produce parts that fit the size of the machine. In this case these machines have a size limitation of 41" x 25" x 25". These machines allowed us to have more capacity for parts of this size so we can do in-house and not send to a supplier.

4. Indigenous Cultural Trail Welcome Shelter

Design and construction of new pavilion in an undeveloped wooded area, built on a circular-shaped, cast-in-place concrete pad. The pavilion features a pedestrian sidewalk that connects the existing welcome center with the Indigenous Cultural Trail in Porter Indiana.

5. RiverEdge Park Pedestrian Bridge

This design is a prime example of our collaborative efforts to improve the quality of life for residents of communities we serve, including the City of Aurora and Northeast Illinois. WBK is deeply honored for this acknowledgement by the APWA, proud to improve pedestrian mobility and access to mass transit, and pleased that RiverEdge Park can become a catalyst for economic growth within the City of Aurora Illinios.



D.A. Dodd Piping and Sheet Metal completed the Plumbing and HVAC scope of the work as well as the new Gaming Floor (opened June 2022).

This project consisted of sheet metal fabrication, piping fabrication, 3D modeling, and newest technology in the construction industry to complete. The 18 month schedule was changed as the team and ownership overcame challenges posed by COVID-19 and maintained a fantastic safety rating. With 45+ craftspeople on the project, delivering a community influencing, safe building is something everyone involved should be proud of.







Our Team installed stainless steel condensate receiver with a larger ASME rated receiver with city water solenoid operating on temperature to safely drain the cool condensate water. Project required cutting concrete, lower existing floor drain and integrating into new poured recessed basin. New tank required recessing into the floor to maintain drainage from the pressure vessel to


