Our admissions process begins by building a relationship with your family while getting to know each student personally. Admissions decisions are based upon entrance testing, previous and current school records, personal interviews, and availability of openings. As a convenience to our applicant families, we utilize an electronic notification and enrollment process.

#### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROSPECTIVE FAMILIES:**

- 2. Click on **Apply** under the Admissions tab.
- 3. Follow the instructions listed to complete application and pay Application Fee.

You will be required to pay \$400 for the Application Fee in order to process the application. This is a non-refundable fee for each application submitted.

#### ADMISSIONS TESTING

Admissions Testing is required for all applicants entering the 1st - 12th grade. The Admissions Test is a Diagnostic Test that helps us gauge where your student is in their current grade level. **Please schedule your student's Admissions Testing as soon as you complete your application**. You will not be able to schedule your Family Interview until this is completed.

- Student Questionnaire (Grades 3-12)
- Transcript (Grades 9-12)
- FHSAA Athletic Questionnaire (if applicable)
