












- LinkedIn is the perfect platform to showcase your professional achievement






### ONE

- Have a concise and description
   About Me section, highlighting
   your skills and experiences.
- Be active, showcase your personal and professional projects that demonstrate your skills.
- Contribute to open-source projects to gain recognition and improve your profile.





### **TWO**

#### Organise and

showcase your projects







- Focus on projects that showcase your strongest languages, and ensure these are being demonstrated.
- Whilst important to showcase your strengths, it is important to demonstrate you are an active learner so be proud of your learning experiences.
- Explain your architectural decisions, this helps to showcase your expertise and can be helpful during the interview process.







### **THREE**

Focus on code quality,
documentation and
open-source contributions







- Write comprehensive README files that provides an overview of each project, including its purpose, features, technologies used, and any external resources or acknowledgements.
- Contribute to open-source projects
  related to your interests and career goals,
  and highlight these in your profile, our

- Contribute to open-source projects to show your ongoing commitment to learning and professional growth.






### FIVE
