Do I need a CSCS card?

Unfortunately, as an agency, we are not able to offer apprenticeships to candidates who are working through us for a client, this is because apprenticeship schemes are government-funded and therefore can not be supported through recruitment agencies.

Do you offer CIS?

For any skilled trades, most of our clients will agree to offer CIS payment, however, some of our clients prefer to pay all their workers only by Umbrella.

Do you use umbrella companies?

Yes, we have a preferred supplier list of umbrella companies that will pay all of our workers.





Can labourers be paid CIS?

Legally, we are not able to pay the labourer's CIS.

This is because labourers fall under 'Supervision, direction and control', meaning that legally we can only pay labourers via PAYE Umbrella.
